

**COMMON COUNCIL
COUNCIL ROOM
JANUARY 10, 2017
7:00 P.M.**

The Common Council met in regular session, Mayor Mabie presiding. On roll call: all members present. The Pledge of Allegiance was recited.

Council Member Clough reported on the January 5, 2017 meeting of the Connect Communities Committee regarding: 1) discussion on setting up a Small Business Academy (Wednesdays March, 2017 through April, 2017 at City Hall with courses directed by the Indianhead Community Action Agency – Business Development), 2) approved setting the Small Business Academy class fees at \$15 per class or \$50 for all five classes, 3) requested \$1,200 from the City of Neillsville Economic Development Commission to cover Small Business Academy costs and 4) the Downtown Revolution signs and clings have been completed and are ready for placement.

Council Member Quicker reported on the January 10, 2017 meeting of the Commission on Public Works/Utilities regarding current activities.

Mayor Mabie declared all reports filed as presented with the City Clerk.

City Clerk Roehl presented Chief of Police Klueckmann's reports for December, 2016 complaints, citations, warnings and investigations and totals for 2016.
