Start date for the 1<sup>st</sup> candidate will be upon successful completion of above testing.

Additionally, to allow Chief Klueckmann to extend a tentative offer of employment to his choice of the remaining (3) ranked candidates pending successful completion of a background investigation and to extend a final offer of employment to same candidate pending successful completion of a medical exam, psychological evaluation, and drug screening. Start date for the 2<sup>nd</sup> candidate will be January 2, 2017. All Aye.
